Who can participate?

All pregnant women and families with children under three months old, living in the 12550 zip code area are eligible to be screened for service.

Services are available in English and Spanish.

There are no fees for any of our services which include assessment, home visiting and parenting groups.

Eligible families can participate with Newburgh Healthy Families until their children enter Head Start or kindergarten.
