

PERFORMANCE MEASURE (PM) 3 DEFINITION

Percent of PC1s (primary caregivers) with a depression screen (PHQ-9) within three months of delivery (for prenatal enrollees) or three months of enrollment (for postnatal enrollees)

ALL HFNY MIECHV PERFORMANCE (PM 3)

- Recent Performance: About 90-100% of PC1s across all MIECHV programs received a depression screen within three months of enrollment/delivery
- Starting in Q2 of FY 2023, PC1s had to reach three months of enrollment/delivery during the reporting period to be included in the measure




PM 17 DEFINITION

Percent of PC1s referred to services for a positive depression screen (PHQ-9) who receive one or more service contacts from mental health providers in the community

ALL HFNY MIECHV PERFORMANCE (PM 17)

- Recent Performance: About 30-50% of PC1s referred to services for a positive depression screen across all MIECHV programs received one or more service contacts
- Starting in Q4 of FY 2023, PC1s had to reach three months of enrollment/delivery during the reporting period to be included in the measure











