

PERFORMANCE MEASURE (PM) 5 DEFINITION

Percent of PC1s (primary caregivers) who are biological mothers who were enrolled prenatally or within 30 days after delivery who received a postpartum visit with a healthcare provider within 8 weeks (56 days) of delivery

ALL HFNY MIECHV PERFORMANCE

• About 40% of PC1s across all MIECHV programs received the postpartum OB/GYN visit within 8 weeks of TC's (target child's) birth starting in Q1 of FY 2020 through Q2 of FY 2022, and 50% of PC1s after new MIS reports were created in Q2 of FY 2022.

Recommended Record: 1-56 Days Postpartum OB/GYN visit **Eligibility Requirements:**


- PC1 is female and biological parent of TC
- By the report end date, TC must be at least one day old

Meeting Requirements:

- Eligible case
- OB/GYN check-up entered into PC1 Medical section of MIS with a date between 1-56 days after TCDOB

Records are grouped by worker and then sorted in the following order to assist with worker planning:


- 1. Cases that are eligible and not meeting
- 2. Cases that are eligible and meeting
- 3. Cases that are not eligible and not meeting

Purpose: Displays the events of the participant's case in chronological order, including due dates for paperwork, developmental screens, immunizations, well baby checkups and lead screenings. New Addition: Postpartum OB/GYN 1-56 days visit added
